

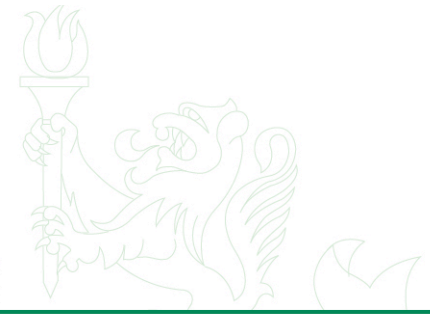

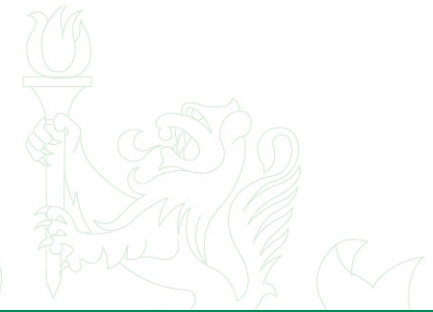

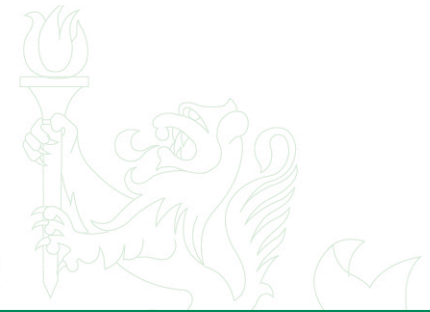

Should the qualification be older than five (5) years the applicant must provide a brief curriculum vitae, in order to establish whether the applicant has been practising the profession and thereby has kept up to date with the practice and the profession; and	xi. 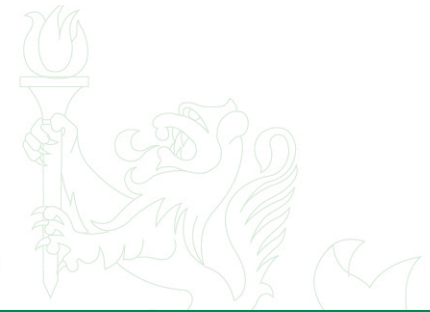
